II. Letters of Recommendation

Two (2) Recommendation Letters: Criteria

Recommendation letters must be: dated within the 2018-19 school year, signed, appear on company letterhead, and have the contact's information.

- **Letter of Recommendation #1- High School Guidance Counselor or Teacher:** Must include:
 - Length of time and the capacity in which they have known the applicant including his/her characteristics
 - Scholastic achievements and/or leadership involvements that qualify the applicant for an award
- **Letter of Recommendation #2- Community Leader:** Must include:
 - Length of time for which they have known the applicant and in what capacity
 - Reputable community service activities/involvement and capacity in which they have known the applicant, applicant characteristics, leadership skills, and other information that will add value to the applicant's packet as a whole. *NOTE: if a church leader writes the letter, it must be in regards to active service in the local community. This does NOT include church involvement or programs regarding different auxiliaries such as choir, usher, praise team, annual concerts, etc.

III. Essay

Prompt and Requirements: Choose prompt #1 or #2.

Prompt #3 is optional to be considered for the Fortitude Scholarship.

1. **SOCIETY**- *What do you consider to be society's biggest issue and how can you help the community overcome it through programming, service, and/or your career goals?*
2. **VOLUNTEERING**- *What community service organization or activity have you participated in that has meant the most to you? Who or what prompted you to work with them? How do you plan to use your experience to help guide your future endeavors?*
3. **OPTIONAL: Additional Essay to be considered for the FORTITUDE SCHOLARSHIP: HARDSHIP**- *Recount a time in your life when you were/are faced with an unforeseen hardship. How did you handle it, what did you learn, and how will the experience impact the next four years of college?*

NOTE: The typed, one-page, 400-500 word essay, must address the prompt and focus on the following:

- Δ Your educational and career goals and how obtaining a scholarship from OACDST will be beneficial to your educational pursuits to transform lives and impact communities based on the prompt of your choice.

To be considered, make sure your packet has the following (*please check off*):

- One 4x6 professional picture of applicant for the Minerva Awards Program
- Complete and return the “Applicant Information” and sections I–V only (*pages 2-5 only*)
- Typed, one-page, essay (*400-500 words*) that addresses one of the three prompts
- Sealed official transcript with GPA, community service hours, and test scores
- In the case that your test scores are not reflected on your transcript, you may include a copy from your college board and/or ACT account.
- Two (2) SIGNED Letters of Recommendation (*review letter requirements*)
- Any additional information that could not fit on the application
- Signed application (*applicant and parent/guardian*)

NOTE: Applications will **NOT** be considered if:

- the applicant did not attend one of the OACDST Scholarship’s fall or spring forums
- it is not mailed and postmarked by the deadline
- transcripts are not sealed
- application packets are incomplete
- the essay does not address one of the two prompts
- application is not signed by applicant and parent/guardian

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SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for a scholarship, applicants must complete this application packet and:

- Attend one of the scholarship forums presented by OACDST. **If you haven't, you're automatically disqualified.**
- Be a current graduating senior from an Orange County public or private school with a spring graduation date.
- Plan to enter an accredited two-year or four-year university or college as a full-time freshman by the following spring. (additional acceptable institutions will be noted depending on scholarship, if applicable)

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD LIST

▲ **SADIE T.M. ALEXANDER:** possess overall qualities of academic achievement, character, leadership, community involvement, and show projected educational long and short-range goals. Note: This is the highest-ranking scholarship awarded to the individual with the highest GPA and/or SAT/ACT score.

▲ **PRESIDENTIAL:** possess general qualifications and high academic achievement. Note: This is the second highest-ranking scholarship awarded to the individual with the second highest GPA and/or SAT/ACT score

▲ **** ALTAMESE PINDER:** meet the general qualifications, aspire to major in education or a related discipline, and demonstrate financial need, and be a graduating senior of Jones High School.

▲ **DELTA GEMS:** general qualifications and be recommended by OAC's Delta GEMS Chairperson.

▲ **EMBODI:** general qualifications and be recommended by OAC's Delta EMBODI Chairperson.

▲ **FORTITUDE:** general qualifications and a compelling story of overcoming obstacles.

▲ **ROSE DANIEL:** general qualifications and aspire to major in education or a related discipline.

▲ **FELDER/HARRISON:** general qualifications and the highest number of documented community service hours.

▲ **NATALIE LITTLES:** general qualifications and aspire to major in Business Administration. Possibly raised by grandparents and able to overcome adversity and succeed against enormous odds.

▲ **** CRIMSON RENAISSANCE DIAMOND EDITION:** general qualifications and have the most elected leadership positions in community service.

▲ **** KITTY JEAN PATTERSON ELLISON SERVANT LEADERSHIP AWARD:** a minimum G.P.A. of 2.5 and demonstrate a consistent and sustained record of community service in the Central Florida community.

▲ **OPPORTUNITY AWARDS:** Recipients may not have required GPA to meet general qualifications listed above, but must have documented community service hours and demonstrate a financial need.

General Qualifications: live within the OACDST service area, 3.0+ unweighted GPA unless otherwise stated, documented quality and consistent community service hours, 1000+ on the SAT, 21+ on the ACT.
